

## Artist Biography

Minna Kokko (b. 1968) is a Finnish visual artist living and working in France.

After completing a Master's degree in international relations in France, she first undertook photography while working in corporate communications in Paris. She trained in small and medium format film photography at Gobelins l'École de l'Image and in digital image processing at Pyramyd in Paris, as well as in creative digital photography at Luova in Helsinki.

Her work has been exhibited regularly in solo and group shows in France and other European countries since 2008. She is currently featured by Artdoc, an international online magazine dedicated to photography. Her work is also featured by Jaguar Arte, an online gallery specializing in art related to nature, as well as by Recurrence Photo, a French agency renting photographic art exhibitions to companies. She also works actively within two artist collectives in the Paris region, and is a member of an international collective of women photographers.
